"Gender quotas in academia"

To address the underrepresentation of women in academia, many countries and institutions have introduced in recent years quotas requiring a minimum share of women (and men) in selection committees and/or among short-listed applicants. I discuss how these quotas affect the characteristics of successful applicants. Furthermore, I also examine the impact of quotas on the research production of senior female researchers, who are forced to spend a disproportionate amount of their time sitting on committees.
